Written Policies and Code of Conduct

Put Policies and Code of Conduct in writing and use them as the foundation for the entire program.



Governance and Compliance Professionals

Delegate an individual or group with operational responsibility, autonomy, and authority.



Training

Create effective, ongoing training methods.



Communication

Establish open lines of communication.



Auditing and Mentoring

Use internal tools to evaluate program effectiveness and detect criminal conduct.



Investigations

Encourage employees to raise concerns and have investigative procedures in place. Resolve identified problems promptly and add related issues to monitoring activities.



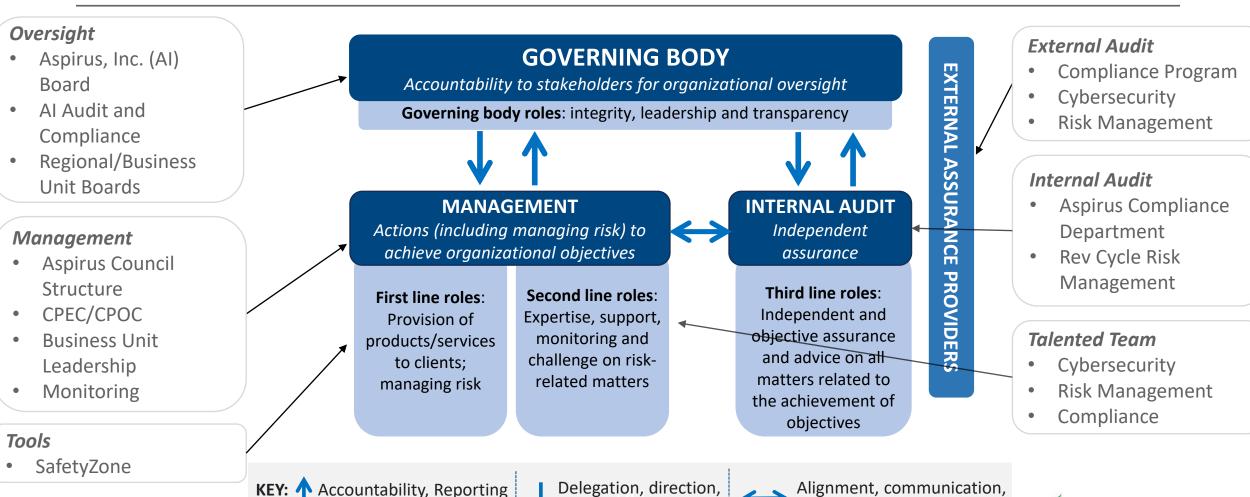
Enforcement of Standards

Establish appropriate incentives for compliance and disciplinary actions for violations.
