#### Friendly Reminder 1: Citrix Workspace is the Gateway into the Aspirus Network

Use the link on the <u>Integration Microsite</u> or open <u>aspirus.cloud.com</u> and sign in for access to Citrix. Citrix is your virtual desktop where you will access all Aspirus applications (you will NOT lose access to your Ascension devices and applications and will continue to access them with your Ascension credentials).

- This is where you will find access to applications like Kronos, Microsoft Office (Word, Excel, PowerPoint, etc.).
- From the home page use **Microsoft Edge** to access the Aspirus Intranet.
- You will need your Aspirus log-in credentials (Aspirus Network ID and Network Password) and confirm your identity using Imprivata two factor authentication.

#### Friendly Reminder 3: Prescription Refills at Retail Pharmacies

All employees at locations new to Aspirus can continue to fill their prescriptions at Ascension retail pharmacies in Rhinelander, Stevens Point, Wausau (Westwood) and Stanley. Those who have used these pharmacies in the past can continue doing so without a disruption in service or coverage.

#### **Certification Documentation Needed**

It is vital to have accurate documentation for our staff and to follow regulatory guidelines and compliance per our policy. Organizational Learning and Development is requesting that all required resuscitation certifications (BLS, ACLS, PALS, NRP and TNCC) for staff be sent to <a href="Resuscitation-AspirusInc@aspirus.org">Resuscitation-AspirusInc@aspirus.org</a> by September 30, 2021. Proper documentation of a certification would be the physical copy of the card from either the American Heart Association, American Red Cross for HealthCare Providers, Emergency Nurses Association and/or American Academy for Pediatrics. No learning transcripts or online completion certificates will be accepted. IMPORTANT: Do not enter your information into Global Human Resources (GHR).
