



## Update on Go Live Scanning Documents to HIM

There is a delay in deploying the Point of Service scanning. We will need to follow an interim process at Go Live until IT is able to get the proper folders added. This will be a temporary process and you will be notified when the proper set up is completed. This process cannot be used long term due to the volume constraints with the fax line and quality of scans.






## Instructions for Setting up a Hot Button

- 1. On the home screen of your Multi-Function Device (MFD). Find the fax button.
  - a. Please note, if your machine is different it will not match the screen shots




2. On the fax screen, hit the plus sign (+) and choose "Program New Destination"








3. On the "Fax Dest." Tab, enter the fax number with the correct long-distance code into the Fax Destination Field and hit OK



4. Go to the "Names" tab and label your folder under the Name field by hitting the 'Change' button. Hospital: Hospital Scan; Clinic: Clinic Scan. Then hit "OK" in the upper right corner.







5. This should complete your set up, and you should see the hot button now on your main fax screen. Please send a test page through noting your location, the machine IP address, and contact information to ensure it is set up correctly. Someone will contact you when to confirm the page was received.
